



## **Nevada Senior Citizen of the Year Nomination Guidelines**

1. The nominee must be a resident of Nevada.
2. The nominee must be 60 years of age as of December 31, prior to the nominated year.
3. The nominee must have been a resident of Nevada for at least 5 years.
4. Recipients will be selected for significant contributions made at the local, state, and/or national level and by excellence achieved through going above and beyond the call of duty, specifically with respect to volunteer work in support of Senior Citizens of the state of Nevada.
5. In addition to the nomination form, please provide a written summary of the significant accomplishments including dates and appropriate documents and testimonials to support the nomination. Also, please provide a recent photo (head shot) of the candidate. (A digital photo should be sent to the email address below.)
6. Nominations will be evaluated on the scope and impact of a nominee's achievements and the extent to which the nominee's efforts benefit(ed) and provide(d) inspiration to their community and other Senior Citizens. These achievements are not limited to only one year and may include those made before the nominee reached 60 years of age.
7. Posthumous nominations are acceptable.
8. Nominations will be reviewed and the recipients will ultimately be chosen by the Nevada Delegation of the National Silver Haired Congress and the Aging Services Directors Organization.
